Food licenses - Food vendors must display their Apache County food licenses. Proof of licensure must be made available to us by May 25, 2018. Please e-mail Liz Castillo at

lizcastillo@co.apache.az.us to apply for your food permit as early as possible to avoid delays.

Sales tax - Vendors are responsible for any sales tax reporting and/or payments. GCA is not responsible for sales tax. We provide space but no furnishings of any kind.

Location, location, location - Heavenly Vendor Village is in the heart of Greer at the Greer Community Center. Almost all activities are held within walking distance of vendors. The parade will pass by vendors and the Community Center at 10 a.m. on Saturday.

Vendor set-up - Vendors can begin setting up at 7 a.m. on Friday, June 7, at the Greer Community Center. At that time, information on setting up and other assistance will be available from volunteers at the Community Center. Booths are open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Friday and Saturday. If you are arriving on Saturday, be aware that Main Street leading to your location will be closed to traffic around 9 a.m. for the parade at 10 a.m.

Evening security - The Greer Civic Association will provide a security guard on Friday night (7 p.m. to 7 a.m.) The Greer Community Center will be locked at night for security. The Greer Civic Association is not responsible for loss or damage incurred to person or property while you are in Greer for Greer Days. You must sign the separate Release and Indemnity Agreement in order to occupy your space and be a vendor for Greer Days.

Parking - We will help you find parking across the street from the Community Center in the field or in other areas nearby. If your booth is a trailer, please let us know so that you can be assigned to the appropriate space. Hookups and utilities are not available at the outdoor booths.

Lodging/Camping - For information about lodging and camping availability, please go to www.greerarizona.com with its many choices of lodges, cabins, rooms, and campsites. Ice can be bought from village businesses. Water is available from the restroom faucets at the Greer Community Center. Restrooms are open during regular hours at the Community Center. Porta-Johns are also located near the outdoor booths. Campers please note: There are no open fires as June is high fire season in the mountains. Please check the fire danger sign as you enter Greer for the latest fire conditions.

Weather - Weather is unpredictable, ranging from beautiful warm, sunny days to cloudy with possible rain and/or wind. June is normally dry in Arizona.

Reminder - Vendors must keep all products, display items and booth materials inside the assigned booth space. Unacceptable behavior or failure to follow rules may result in closure of the booth as well as access to future space and all fees. No alcohol or illegal drugs are permitted.

Signing this application verifies that you have read and agree with the terms and conditions as set forth on this application. Sign both this application and the Release and Indemnity Agreement and have both forms to the appropriate address listed above no later than Tuesday, June 4, 2019, along with your payment. In the event that we receive applications from vendors selling the same products, the earliest application will be considered first. Payment will secure your booth upon acceptance.
